



LOTTERY SUCCESS FOR ST ANNE'S CHAPEL!

The Town Council is delighted to announce that its bid to Heritage Lottery Fund has been successful.

This money, combined with funding from Devon County Council of £75,000 and the Town Council's own contribution, means that plans can now go ahead to repair and restore this historic Grade I Listed building, bringing it back to life as St Anne's Cultural Centre.



St Anne's Chapel is one of Barnstaple's oldest buildings and has a rich and diverse history spanning more than six centuries. The Town Council wants the building



to be a vibrant part of 21st century Barnstaple, whilst still retaining its unique heritage and history.

Mayor of Barnstaple, Cllr Ian Roome, said:

"The Town Council is delighted to have been successful in its bid for Heritage Lottery Funding and to have received additional financial support from Devon County Council. This work will bring St Anne's back into the heart of the community."

HOMECOMING PARADE

Barnstaple Town Council is organising a Homecoming Parade on Thursday 17th November 2011 for troops from the Commando Logistic Regiment Royal Marines, returning from Afghanistan.

The parade will commence at 10.30am from Taw Vale, and for the safety of spectators the following roads will be closed:

The Strand, Castle Street and Cross Street - Closed from 9.00am to 12 noon.

The Longbridge and the Square - Closed from 10.15am to 12 noon.

Please be aware that there may be a slight delay on other routes in the town while the march is in progress.

Hand waving flags are available from the Town Council offices at Barum House on the Square, or from Barnstaple Heritage Centre on the Strand, or look out for our sellers on the day. All money raised will go to The Royal Marines Charitable Trust Fund.

THE ROUTE

Troops will form up at Taw Vale and march to the Square. From the Square they will cross into Boutport Street and turn left into High Street, marching the full length of the High Street to Mermaid's Cross. Turning left, the parade marches down North Walk into Castle Street and the Strand where the salute will be taken near to the Heritage Centre. The parade then crosses the Square and back to Taw Vale.

WAR MEMORIAL RESTORED TO FORMER GLORY

The two year programme of repairs and restoration of Barnstaple's War Memorial, situated in Rock Park, is now complete.

2010 saw extensive repairs to the stone work and the provision of new slip wires and chain fencing, and this year the work has been completed by repair and restoration of the plaques on the Memorial.

The work has been carried out by Fine Memorials and Bronze Restoration Ltd and the Memorial is now ready for the Children's Remembrance Service on 11th November and the town's Remembrance Day Service on Sunday, 13th November, to which all are welcome.

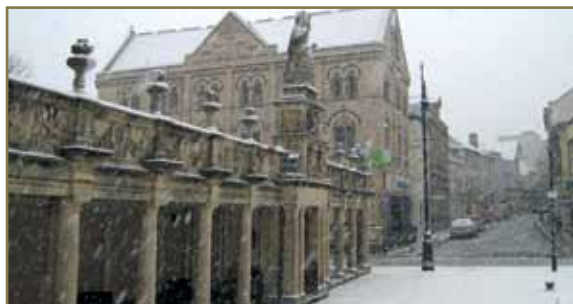
Help, History Box & Christmas Exhibition

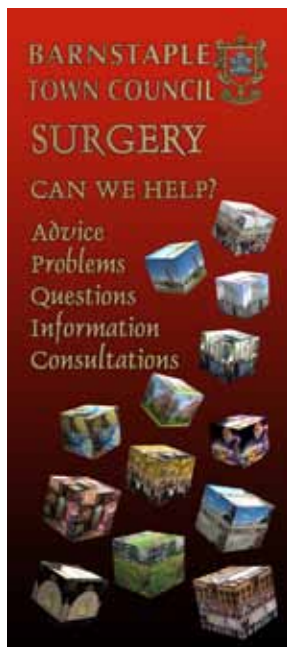
