## Introduction

This is the fourth year running that the Town Council has held a 'Tidy up our Town' week in Barnstaple.

The initial campaign was founded by the Town Council's Environment Committee after Members attended the 'It's in our hands: Environmental Expo Event' in the Pannier Market back in February 2008. At the event the Environment Committee held a public consultation to find out the environmental concerns of the public within the town.

After analysing the feedback it was clear that litter in the town was the public's top concern, therefore, the Environment Committee resolved to hold a 'Tidy up our Town' week.

Last years' event saw over **400 people** taking part, including at least **100 school children!** **11 skip loads of rubbish** were collected, and over **150 bags of rubbish and recycling** removed from our streets and communities.

This years event will once again encourage local organisations, agencies and community groups to hold litter pick events within the town, to help make Barnstaple a better and brighter place for everyone to enjoy.

## Launch Event Monday 13 June, The Guildhall, 10.00am.

This is your chance to see the magnificent murals completed by the local primary schools. There will be guest speakers and light refreshments. Come along to the official opening of this weeklong event.

## Murals

This year fantastic colourful murals were completed to help promote Tidy up our Town. The following schools took part in this project: **Ashleigh Primary School, Forches Cross Primary School, Lampard Vachell School, Newport Primary School, Our Lady's School, Orchard Vale Community School, Pathfield School, Pilton Bluecoat School, Sticklepath Community School, Yeo Valley Primary School.**
